Adventure Learning is a Branch Campus of Colorado Homeschool Enrichment (CHE). Enrolled families for 2025-2026 will receive FREE ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES.

Program includes

- Tuition/fees at approved enrichment provider: Lighthouse Christian Academy
- 2 Adventure Learning Day Field Trips each month
- Academic Advising opportunities including learning assessments
- Career Assessment with a consultation by a career coach (\$400 value!) for ages 12+
- 1 year membership to IXL for individualized learning support (\$240 value!)

Requirements

Students are required to attend 90 hours of enrichment per semester. Adventure Learning requires enrollment in 5 or more Lighthouse classes. Lighthouse students who are enrolled for a full 6 hours of Friday enrichment classes for the entire 15-week semester will meet the required hours. "After Hours" classes like the SALT Speech and Debate team, theater production rehearsals, or the optional Adventure Learning Days field trips may also be used to satisfy the 90 hour minimum.

Students cannot be enrolled in another state funded program (Brighton Options, Summit Academy, etc) Lighthouse Christian Academy is still available for self-pay enrollment. Families enrolled in other state funded programs can switch to Adventure Learning as their state-funded option for 2025-2026.
